The Nez Pierce war continues at a Nez Pierce camp. The Nez Pierce leaders had led their people on an extensive trek after the Battle of the Clearwater to escape the soldiers of General Olive Otis Howard. Unknown to the Nez Pierce, Colonel John Gibbon had left Fort Shaw with 161 officers and men and one howitzer. Between Gibbon's position and the Nez Pierce encampment, which consisted of 89 tipis in a v-shaped pattern, was waist-deep willow lined North Fork of the Big Hole River. Approaching the Nez Pierce encampment on foot at dawn, Gibbon's men encountered an old Nez Pierce man. They killed him. 20 minutes after his entry into the village, and Gibbon, realizing that he was in an "uncomfortable position", ordered a retreat across the river to a timbered forest 300-400 yards away. This day was important because it showed us that this was their land and that we should show respect for them.

The Montana State Capitol Building is Finished Date 1902

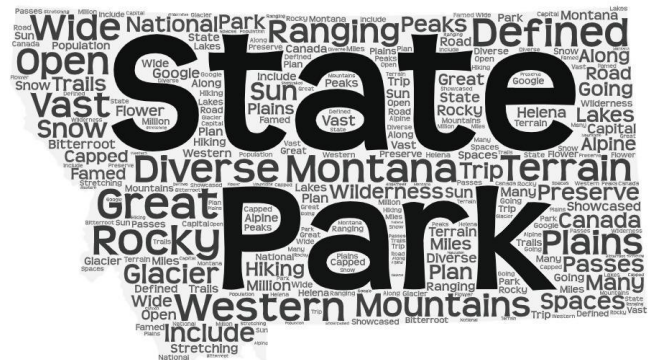

The Sioux and Northern Cheyenne natives won a battle between General George Crook and his troops. This battle started and ended on June 17, 1876.

Twenty-eight men were lost and 56 severely injured. It represented the 15000 Sioux and Northern Cheyenne as they fought against Crook's 1,000 men at the Little Rosebud Creek in Bighorn County. 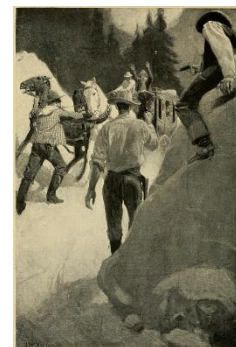
VIGILANTES vs.
